Professional Musical Training

The Summer Orchestra Academy hires a team of the finest music teachers in our region. All of our senior staff have degrees in teaching music and work with students on a regular basis.

We also employ college and high school students as "mentors." Mentors serve as role models and inspiration to our younger students.

By the final night of camp, the staff and students will perform a brief concert showcasing the musical training they have received.

Keep them playing

You paid for the instrument. They should be PLAYING it. Orchestra Academy is a great way to keep kids playing over the summer.

Learn Life Lessons

We don't just want good players, we want good kids. This year we are focussing on gratitude, responsibility, attitude, courage, and encouragement.

Life Lessons

There's a lot more to life than music. However, we believe music is one of the finest ways to teach some of the most important lessons. Each week, students will be challenged to develop themselves as people (not just musicians). This year's theme is GRACE: Gratitude, Responsibility, Attitude, Confidence and Encouragement.

All Inspire Academy activities have a Christian foundation. This isn't a bible camp, but students will have the opportunity to pray and learn in a Christian environment. All faith backgrounds are welcome and accepted in the academy.

Optional Overnight

After the concert on Friday, students are invited to spend the whole night celebrating. There will be pizza, pop, games, movies and a night full of fun. Saturday morning, the staff will make breakfast for the campers and send them home exhausted, smelly and happy. Students who spend the night will pay \$15 to cover food and prizes. Pick-up at 10 am.

Alternatively, you can pick up your child at midnight. Some students (and parents) may not be comfortable spending the night, but still want the fun. This option is \$10. You can also opt out of all late night activities if you wish. No pressure.
